



PUBLIX SUPER MARKET #720— ATLANTA, GA., ACQUISITION REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

In mid 1999, Publix Super Markets, Inc. acquired nine sites in the Atlanta area from A&P Supermarkets. Lindsay ♦ Pope ♦ Brayfield & Associates, Inc. was selected to design a new one-of-a-kind Publix Super Market for the upscale Buckhead neighborhood of Atlanta

Due to site zoning restrictions, the prototype was modified to fit within the footprint of the existing A&P Store.

LPB redesigned the interior, working closely with Publix Facilities, to encompass all requirements into a compact, irregular floor plan.

LPB designed a unique exterior to further enhance the store's appearance for this up-scale neighborhood in North Atlanta.
