



LILBURN MIDDLE SCHOOL

Three buildings dating back to the 1940's composed the original campus at Lilburn Middle School. The explosive growth in school enrollment created the need for the addition of a 77,000 sq. ft., 2-story facility, to house the growing student population. During the expansion, the original three buildings were totally renovated.

LPB's structural engineer met the challenge of moving walls about in the existing buildings by incorporating new structural systems. The renovation also included tying the exterior facades together with the unifying brick design.

To further unify the design from a student circulation point-of-view, the civil engineer and landscape architect created a courtyard commons, connecting the buildings together through a pleasantly landscaped plaza which allows the students to move from building to building in a protected environment. Since land on this site was at a premium, our civil engineer was also able to provide parking and drives to tie the site together cohesively for access by both students in buses and parent delivery.

The student growth in the Lilburn area has continued, and LPB added a second 2-story building in 1996, to bring the number of students to almost 2,000 at this campus
